Krzysztof Marasek, graduated in computer science from the Technical University of Warsaw, Poland, obtained the doctor degree from the Institute of Fundamental Technological Research (IFTR) in Warsaw (1992), habilitated (D.Sc.) in 1997 at the University of Stuttgart and finally nominated professor in 2015. 1998-2004 appointed as a Senior Scientist at the Sony Stuttgart Technology Centre, from 2006 graduate stuff faculty member and visiting professor of University of North Carolina, Charlotte, US, member of scientific boards of the IFTR and IPI (Information Processing Institute, Warsaw). Actually is heading the Mutlimedia Department, Polish-Japanese Academy of Information Technology. Reviewer and expert in 5th and 6th EU Framework programmes (advanced signal processing), partner in Babel (Copernicus 1304), SpeeCon (IST-1999-10003), LUNA (IST 033549), EU-Bridge (grant agreement n°287658) and Clarin-PL projects. His work focuses on human-computer interaction, speech processing, persistent long-term data archiving and multimedia content analysis. He is an author or co-editor of 9 books, about 100 publications, 18 European and 6 US patents.t
